Flag City Honor flights back in full swing

As part of the National Honor Flight Network, Flag City Honor Flight provides local veterans

from Hancock County and the surrounding region with a flight to Washington, D.C., for a visit to the nation's war memorials.

The Findlay-based hub services not only Hancock County but all of Northwestern Ohio, in fact, as well as veterans in southeastern Michigan. During flight days, deputies from

Hancock, Wood and Lucas County Sheriff's offices and Legion Riders escort these veterans to the Toledo Express Airport.

Four flights are scheduled for 2023, on April 18, June 13, Sept. 12 and Nov. 7.

After a break in flights due to COVID, Flag City Honor Flight was excited to come back in 2022.

Last July, President Bob Weinberg announced a first-time third flight to be added in November. While the first two flights, in June and September, were standard flights, the November flight was an all Vietnam-era veteran

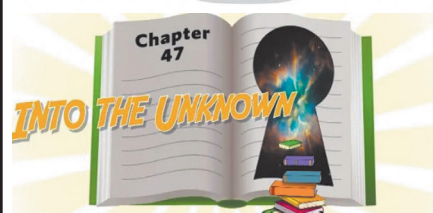

which is funded independently on donations from the community. Community members also volunteer to become “guardians” and accompany veterans on these trips to the nation’s capital.

Each flight is costly for the organization, but charitable funds from sponsorships and donations from corporations, area businesses, schools, military groups, churches and individuals support the logistics and expenses. It costs nothing for the veterans on the flights.

In 2022, the Gilmore Jasion Mahler Wanderlust: A Stroll Through Paris fundraiser raised over \$200,000 for Flag City Honor Flight to continue the flights. The organization also received various amounts in donations from the Defiance VFW Post #3360, Toledo Emblem Club #500, and the Bluffton

American Legion Post 382, as well as other organizations, schools, events and fundraisers.

The Findlay-based company, Ohio Logistics, has been a long-time supporter of Flag City Honor Flight and sponsored the entire third flight. Company president Chuck Bills committed to paying it forward to others — he said he is passionate about the organization’s work and showing appreciation toward veterans.

“We need to do all we can to make sure these veterans have a true welcome home,” Bills said in July.

On board the final flight of 2022 was Findlay resident LeRoy Rupright, 81, and his granddaughter, Erika.

Rupright, who shared his experience from the Mission #21 flight with The Courier, said it was a sobering

experience and a “truly emotional welcome back.” While in D.C., the group visited war memorials, Arlington Cemetery and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. He loved being able to get to experience the welcome home with his granddaughter, especially recounting how their bus was able to run red lights with Bowling Green firetrucks spraying water at them.

Mayor Christina Muryn, who also went on the flight as a guardian, said it was wonderful.

Over 400 names are on a waiting list to be on a flight to Washington D.C., some waiting over six years. About 250 veterans were on board the three flights in 2022, an average of about 80 veterans per flight.

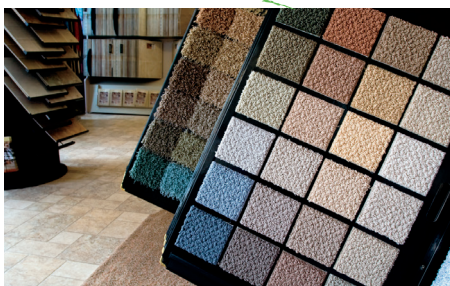

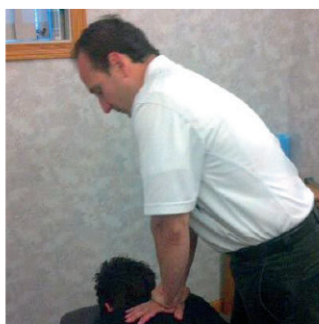

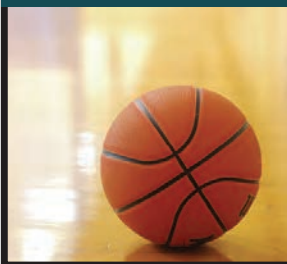

Budget-friendly ways to freshen up your home's exterior

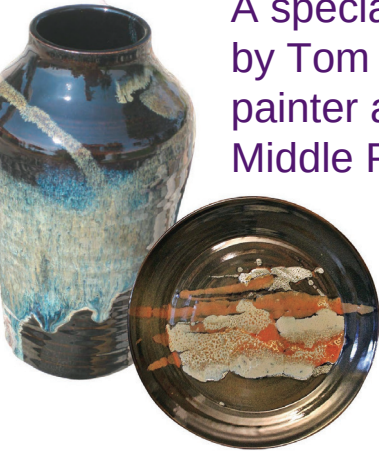

5 signs it's time to renovate

Homeowners renovate their homes for a variety of reasons. Renovations can increase the value of a property and make homes safer and more comfortable for their occupants. Improvements also can be made to stay current with the times or to give a home a new vibe.

Statista projects \$510 billion will be spent on home improvements in 2024. The home improvement market is generating significant revenue. In fact, nearly a quarter of Americans opting to renovate their homes will spend an average of \$10,000 on their projects.

Age The National Association of Home Builders states that 50 percent of U.S. homes are over the age of 40. That means that age alone could dictate a

need to renovate, particularly if some materials are original to the home. For example, asphalt roofs typically last 25 to 30 years, while window frames can last 20 to 50 years depending on how well they have been maintained.

Inconvenient layout Some homeowners scratch their heads when faced with awkward floor plan layouts. While one may live with the inconvenience for some time, typically a floor plan that isn't working for the homeowner is a major driver of renovations.

Outdated looks A home can look dated even if it is a relatively recent build. That's because trends change quickly. For example, dark, cherry cabinets that were popular just a little while ago have now been replaced by lighter color palettes. Honey oak cabinets and woodwork which were a staple in the '80s and '90s also being replaced. Homeowners whose homes do not match the looks

emulated in design magazines may consider a change, particularly if they're planning to sell soon.

Deterioration Signs of water, storm or structural damage should be addressed as soon as possible. Any deterioration should be a strong indicator that it's time to renovate.

Efficiency Escalating utility bills could be indicative of an inefficient home. Homeowners can conduct energy audits and then improve the areas where energy loss may be occurring, such as windows, doors, siding, and insulation.

Homeowners can renovate their homes when they see fit, but various signs may warn that it's time consider updating or remodeling a home. Don't wait until you are ready to put your home on the market for resale...allow time for your own family to enjoy the benefits of the updates.

St. Patrick's Day Recipes



Potatoes are the star of this Irish dish

St. Patrick's Day is a time to pay homage to Ireland's patron saint and celebrate Irish culture and cuisine. Even though corned beef and cabbage is ubiquitous on this holiday, that meal really isn't the most authentic Irish cuisine. There are plenty of

other foods to dress the St. Patrick's table if a person wants to dabble in Irish cooking.

Many cultures have a variation on the potato pancake, and the Irish are no different. Boxty is a traditional Irish potato

pancake. Individuals who want to include boxty in their celebrations can try this recipe, courtesy of Chef Pádraic Óg Gallagher of Gallagher's Boxty House in Dublin.



Irish Boxty

Makes about 10

10 ½ oz. raw potatoes, peeled

2 ½ tsp. salt

10 ½ oz. cooked potatoes, mashed

3 1/2 cups milk

10 ½ oz. flour

Grate the raw potatoes into a muslin cloth and squeeze as much liquid as possible into a bowl. Let liquid stand for 20 minutes. Gently pour off the liquid and keep the starch that settled in the bottom of the bowl.

Add grated potatoes to mashed potatoes and flour. Add starch and salt to mix. Slowly add 3/4 of the milk to form a batter of pouring consistency. Depending on the potato, you may not need to use all the milk. If the batter is too heavy, add more milk. Leave batter resting for 30 minutes.

Drop a ladle full onto an oiled nonstick pan over medium heat and cook on the first side for 2 minutes (this depends on how heavy the batter is and how much you use). Check color (it should be a nice golden color) on the bottom. Adjust heat if necessary. Turn and cook on the other side for 2 to 3 minutes more.

Crockpot Reuben Dip

Ingredients

8 oz. plain cream cheese, cubed

¼ cup Thousand Island dressing

1 cup thinly sliced corned beef, chopped

1 cup Sour Cream

1 cup Swiss Cheese, grated

8 oz. Sauerkraut, drained

Serve with: Rye crackers, toasted rye party bread or veggies

Add all ingredients to crock pot and stir. Cover and cook on high 45 minutes, stirring every 15 minutes, until all the cheese has melted. Serve hot with your favorite bread, crackers or veggies.
